### **Congratulations Marion Hamilton!**


At the Scouts' Green and Gold Banquet on February 20, Marion Hamilton was awarded the God and Service religious award. This award for scout leaders is by nomination only and "is given to acknowledge distinguished volunteer service...in ministry to young people through service to the Church and one or more of the national agencies" (e.g. Scouting America). The criteria for this award includes being of service to a scout unit and a church for 5+ years, encouraging youth to earn the religious award for their faith and promote community service, and being a great example of a Christian to their church and its youth. It is believed that Marion is only the second scout leader to earn this award in the history of Scout Troop 30 and the first in several decades. Congratulations, Marion!

#### **Online Giving Processing Fees**

The people of New Hope have such generous hearts! All contributions that are made, whether by cash, check, or online through the *Vanco website*, are greatly appreciated.

In order to offer the online payment portal through Vanco, New Hope incurs a fee per transaction. In 2024, we paid over \$1,300 in online processing fees. In order to help our budget and to help reduce the expense of these fees, the option to add the .7% ACH processing fee to your online contribution has been added on the Vanco website. This equates to 7 cents for every \$10.

Please note, while this is a required fee that New Hope pays, the choice is whether you, as the contributor, are willing to assume it, rather than passing it along to the church. If you choose not to pay the fee, you may decline by clicking the button to the off position that reads "I would like to help offset the processing fees associated with online giving" (pictured below). If turned off, then the .7% ACH processing fee will not be added to your contribution.

New Hope has chosen not to accept debit/credit cards, as the processing fees for those are substantially higher.


