

2025 Per Capita

As you may know, our church, like every Presbyterian congregation, is responsible for paying per capita for each active member. The per capita amount for 2025 is \$40.00 per member in each household (for example, a family of two (2) members would pay \$80.00).

This amount for the Giddings-Lovejoy Presbytery is the annual contribution per member that funds the work of the Presbytery. The per capita amount also funds the National Office of General Assembly, the Office of the Stated Clerk, and the Presbyterian Mission Agency. It is a pledge made as Presbyterians to the greater church.

You can pay your per capita with the designated envelope provided with your 2025 giving envelopes, designate the per capita on the memo line of a check, or pay online *here*.
