2025 Safe Sanctuary Training Update

The NHPC Safe Sanctuary Handbook was recently revised and approved by Session just in time for VBS Safe Sanctuary Training! (The majority of New Hope folks volunteering to work directly or indirectly with children and youth are in need of updating their Safe Sanctuary certification.)

VBS Safe Sanctuary Training will be Tuesday, June 3 at 1 pm in Rm 104, and Thursday June 5 at 6:30 pm in Rm. 100. We are asking ALL VBS volunteers to sign up for one of these training sessions as there are new policy updates and procedures we will be rolling out. This training will be different from past sessions, offering attendees a more “hands-on” approach to practice and discuss many Safe Sanctuary situations. A sign up sheet is now in the Narthex along with the Revised 2025 Safe Sanctuary Handbooks. It is suggested trainees look over the handbook before the training and bring it to the session with them.

If you have had Safe Sanctuary training within the past year, you still need to go through the new training. This will ensure everyone is operating with the most up-to-date policies and procedures for the safety of our children and youth!
